All groups who are either a Neighborhood Association, Non-Profit, Not for Profit, or School related organization (area schools given a priority ranking) are provided the opportunity to participate in each open-air fresh market we currently operate. *Please note: Political Groups will not be accommodated.

Guidelines for Community Group Participation:

- Due to space limitations there will be a limited number of spaces reserved for Community Groups/Organizations per Market event.
- All groups who are interested in participating and have been approved will be provided space for a 6-8ft. table space at a discounted cost and on the date requested if available.
- All groups applying to sell food items must intend to sell foods that are healthy and made with no artificial ingredients or preservatives. Food items must not be in direct competition to the foods already approved and selling in the market. Please check with the market manager before applying to get an update as to which items are currently being sold.
- Tables, chairs and/or tents will not be provided by market organizers. The participating groups must furnish these items.
- There is no guarantee that a space will be available to fit a tent. All groups interested must request a tent space if one is needed. *There is no guarantee that the date requested on the application will be available.
- All spaces are provided on a first come, first serve basis. All groups are welcome to attend for more than one event per season as the market schedule allows; however due to on-going requests for space, no one group will be given a presence for all market events during the season. *All groups who are on the waiting list to participate will be given priority for the first space available at the next market event.
- Please note any Group or Organizations creating a disturbance during market operation hours can and will be asked to leave the market at any time.
- Tampa Bay Markets, Inc. management for each market reserves the right to decline participation or market presence for any group. ***Please note: Political Groups will not be accommodated.**
